



## **Who is Jesus?**

Part 6: The God-man — Fully God (according to his words)

### Discussion

*Read John 8:51-58; John 17:1-5*

What is Jesus claiming about himself in these passages?

How does this claim relate to the promise of Genesis 3:15?

*Read Ephesians 1:3-4*

When did the Father and the Son, (together with the Holy Spirit) covenant w/one another to save us from our sins? Before or after God created the heavens and the earth?

Given that God does not change, the phrase, “before the foundation of the world,” implies this was an eternal covenant within the Triune God to create and save a people for himself.

How does it make you feel, knowing God chose in eternity past, not only to create you, but to save you from your sins, that you might know and enjoy him forever?

What does this reveal about God’s trustworthiness? His good intentions toward us in Christ?

What would it look like, practically, to live in light of these things?
