



## **Who is Jesus?**

### Part 11: Our Only Hope

We've seen throughout this series that Jesus, the promised one of Genesis 3:15 truly is our best and only hope. Through our union with him by grace, through faith in his perfect life, sacrificial death, resurrection, and ascension into glory, God renews and restores us to flourish in him as he created us to do. As we wrap up this series, let's consider how, what Jesus did for brings us into a brand new life with him, through which we fill the earth with God's glory by increasingly becoming like him.

### **Read Philippians 2:1-18**

Outline Paul's thought process in this passage. *What is he trying to convey in this passage?*

### **Re-read verses 5-11**

*What, specifically, did Jesus do to rescue us from sin, reconcile us to God and make us new?*

### **Re-Read Verse 2:12-13**

This command comes immediately after Paul's description of what God has done in Christ to make us His. To "work out your salvation" means to live out or live in light of the salvation God has granted us in Christ.

*How, specifically, are we to do this?*

*Why should this be our response to God's love toward us in Christ?*

### **Re-Read Philippians 2:1-5; 14-18**

*Who will we increasingly look like as we live out the salvation God has purchased for us in Christ?*
