Part 8: The God-man — Fully God (according to the Apostles)

Discussion

Read John 1:1-4, 14

Who are these verses referring to?

If “The Word” is Christ, what do verses 1-4 reveal about Christ’s nature?

According to verse 14, what did the Word (Son of God) do to make us his?

Did the eternal Son of God remain God when he became a man? (See Colossians 1:15-17; 2:9)

Let’s consider how, who Jesus is guarantees he can and will fulfill his promises.

Read John 6:35-44

In these verses, 37-40, what does Jesus say he came to do?

According to these verses, what is the will of the Father for his Son?

Is it possible the Son of God might fail to fulfill the will of his Father? Why or why not?

According to verses 37 and 40, respectively, who is responsible for your salvation?

According to verse 39, is it possible God could lose a Christian? (See also John 10:27-30)

How does it make you feel, knowing your salvation is certain, all and only because the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13-14) guarantee it?
