



## Who is Jesus?

Part 9: The God-man — Fully Human (tho sinless)

### Discussion

*Read Luke 1:31; John 1:14; 1 Timothy 2:5*

The Son of God possesses the very nature of the one and only, eternal God. But, in becoming flesh (John 1:14), he entered Adam's race and became fully human like us.

*Beyond the fact that only the perfect man could pay the penalty for man's sins, what does the incarnation (God becoming man) say about:*

*The kind of God he is and his intentions toward us? (See John 10:14-15)*

*The nature of God's Kingdom and what it means to follow Christ? (See Philippians 2:5-11).*

### **Read Hebrews 4:14-16**

The sinlessness of Jesus Christ qualified Him to pay the death penalty for our sins. *According to Hebrews 4:16, how should this affect the way we live as his people? Why?*

*In addition to qualifying Him to cancel sin's power to condemn us ever again, how does Jesus's familiarity with and victory over sin encourage you in your personal struggle against sin?*

### **Read John 15:4-7**

*How do we who are His enter and enjoy Christ's victory over sin? What does this look like practically?*
